1. 2. While conducting the project viva-voce examination through video conferencing by using electronic means, it may be ensured that it will be attended by members of Viva Voce Committee and other interested experts / researchers as applicable. It is also imperative on the part of the college to maintain due record of the same, including the report signed by Examiner(s) appointed for conducting the same and submit the same to the University for award of the Degree. A screen shot showing presence of Head of the Department, Internal and External examiner, faculty members and students who should be submitted as proof of attendance.
