INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

Please read the Instructions given below carefully before applying for Admission into Ph.D. Programmes under ADF Scheme 2020-21

1) Number of seats branch wise and roster wise are as given below:

- a) Seats will be filled based on roster norms of Government of A.P.
- b) If the applicants against the roster point is not available, then AP state Government roster norms will be followed to fill the vacancy with other category as per the reservation rules. Thereby it is advised to submit the applications by candidates of all categories in every discipline.
- c) If the number of applications received for a given roster category more than 5, then GATE merit/percentile/score will be set as cutoff for restricting the number of candidates for the interview in the respective discipline.
- 2) The candidates must ensure their eligibility for Ph.D. Admission 2020-21 under AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) Scheme in respect of qualifications and other requisite criteria and then only submit Application form.
- 3) Candidates having the following qualifications are eligible to apply for ADF scheme for PhD admission 2020-21:
 - a) For OC/BC candidates, CGPA requirement will be 7.5 and above on the scale of
 - 10 (or 75% and above marks) or equivalent at both B.E/B.Tech/ and M.E/M.Tech. For SC/ST/PH candidates, CGPA requirement will be 7.0 que above on the scale of 10 (or 70% and above marks) or equivalent at both B.E/B.Tech/ and M.E/M.Tech.
 - b) In addition to the above, the candidate should have qualified in GATE examination during the last 5 years. (i.e. must have appeared in GATE examination in the last five years including GATE 2020 (2020, 2019, 2018, 2017, and 2016) and must have a valid GATE Score). While finalizing the candidates for admission/fellowship, 75% weightage will be given to Gate Score/Percentile and 25% weightage will be given to Interview.

- c) The scholars already undergoing Ph.D. programme in the Universities /Institutes are not eligible for drawing fellowship from AICTE under ADF Scheme. Only the scholars admitted for ADF scheme from the year of its implementation i.e. 2020-21 are eligible to draw fellowship from AICTE after fulfilling the guidelines for admission.
- 4) OC/BC Category candidates have to pay **Rs.1500/-** and SC/ST/PH Category candidates have to pay **Rs.1250/-** towards Application Registration fee in the form of Demand Draft in favor of "**The Registrar, JNT University Anantapur**", payable at **SBI, JNTUEC Branch (Code No. 2723), Ananthapuramu**.

Note: Application Registration fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

- 5) The filled application along with DD and Xerox copies of certificates must be sent to the Office of the Director of Admissions, JNT University Anantapur, Ananthapuramu through Speed Post/Courier to reach on or before 20.12.2020, 5.00 PM.

 - vi. Xerox copy of Migration Certificate in case of other than JNTUA
 - vii. Xerox copy of Integrated Caste Certificate
 - viii. Xerox copies of Study Certificates of both UG and PG
 - ix. Xerox copy of valid GATE score card
 - x. Xerox copy of SSC certificate
- 7) Application received after last date notified will not be entertained and no further correspondence will be made in this regard.
- 8) University will not be responsible for any delay at any stage. No correspondence / queries will be entertained regarding delays, conduct and result of interview and reasons for not being called.
- 9) The University reserves the right not to admit any candidate in any discipline if none is found suitable / eligible by the Expert / Interview committee.
- 10) The University reserves the right to alter / insert any corrections / additions in the advertisement / website etc. in the event of thing is observed.
- 11) The decision of the University in all matters will be final and binding. No correspondence / interim enquiry will be entertained from the candidates in connection with the process of selection / interview.
- 12) No accommodation / travel allowance etc. will be provided by the University to the candidates called for interview.
- 13) Candidates are advised to see the university website regularly for any future updates/information etc.

Fee Structure: Tuition Fee: Rs 40,000 /- per Year; [Caution Deposit: Rs 500/- + Admission Fee: Rs 200/- + Identity Card Fee: Rs 150/- at the time of Admission only]. Fee structure may vary from time to time as per the rules and regulations of the University.
