Suggested to energise the alumni network for mentorship, students can get connected to the industry with alumni interactions.

Legal Structure  
Suggested section 8 Company which should be separate entity from university

MoUs (Collaboration and Knowledge Exchange)  
Incubation centre can sign MoU's and can collaborate with any agency based on university constraints.

Exit Policy  
Three years is the Incubation period that may increase or decrease on Incubatee and university.
