REPORT

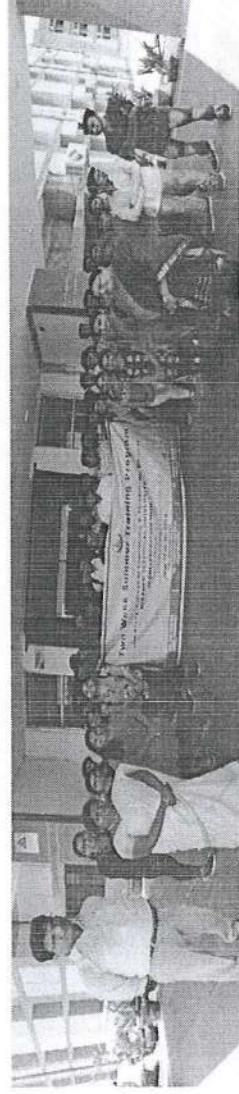

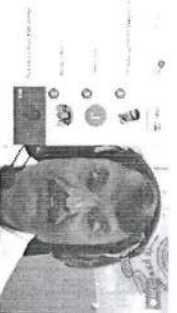
REPORT

The FDP was inaugurated on 14-12-2020 by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of Rayalaseema University, Kurnool and i/c VC of JNTUA, Prof. A.Ananda Rao Sir. In his inaugural address, he stated the role of a teacher in moulding the character of students. The Principal of JNTUACEA, Prof. K. 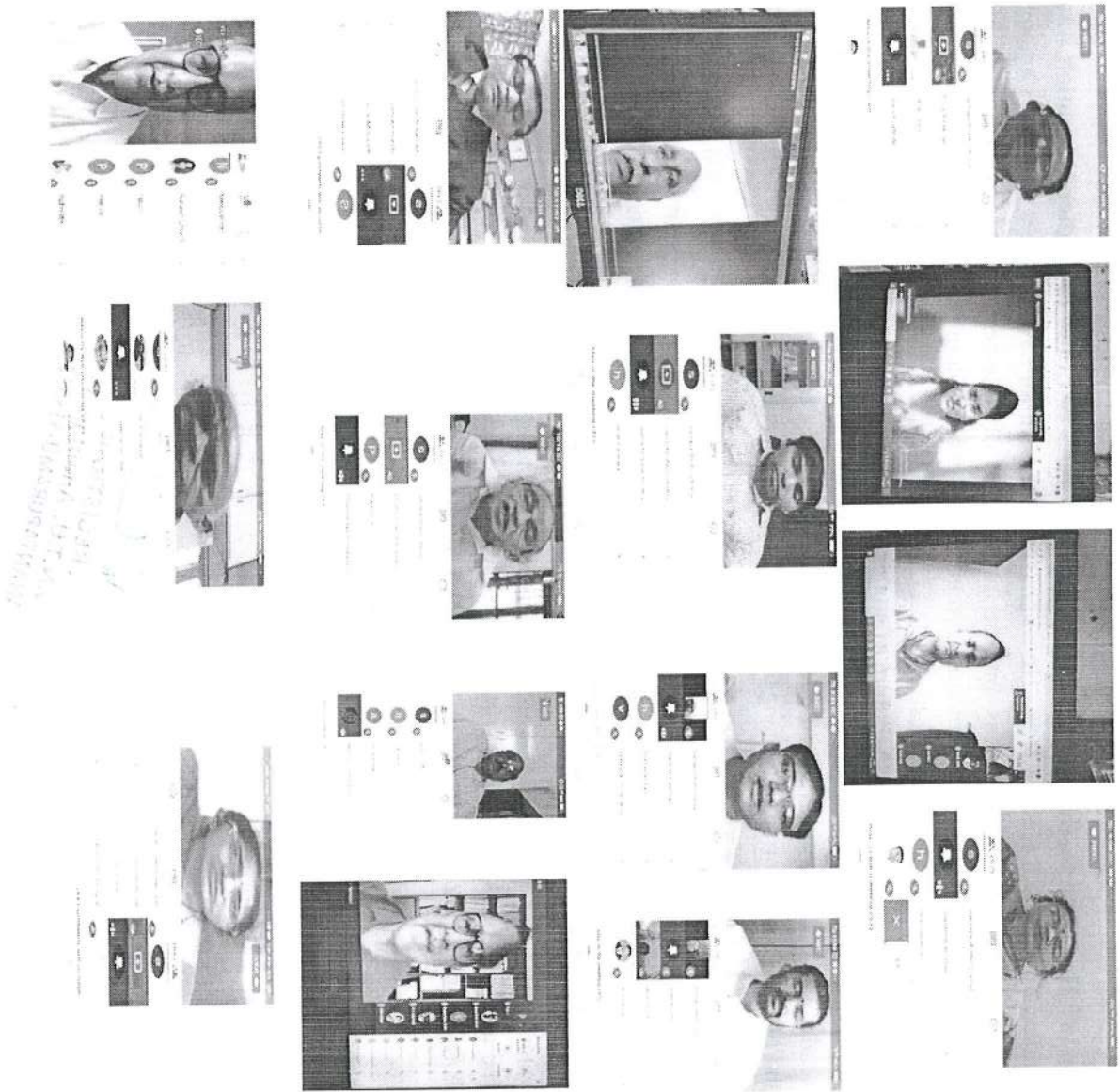

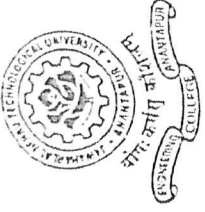

Effective communication paves a way to achieve success and helps to maintain cordial relations among the human beings. Listening skill is one of the most important among four skills (L-S-R-W) of a language. It is one most important receptive skill for acquisition of information and knowledge. Presentation skills comprise verbal and non-verbal skills. Under verbal communication (L-S-R-W), we use appropriate and contextual diction for effective communication where as we use appropriate body language (gestures, signs, facial expressions etc) and para language (tone, touch, volume etc.,) in non-verbal communication. 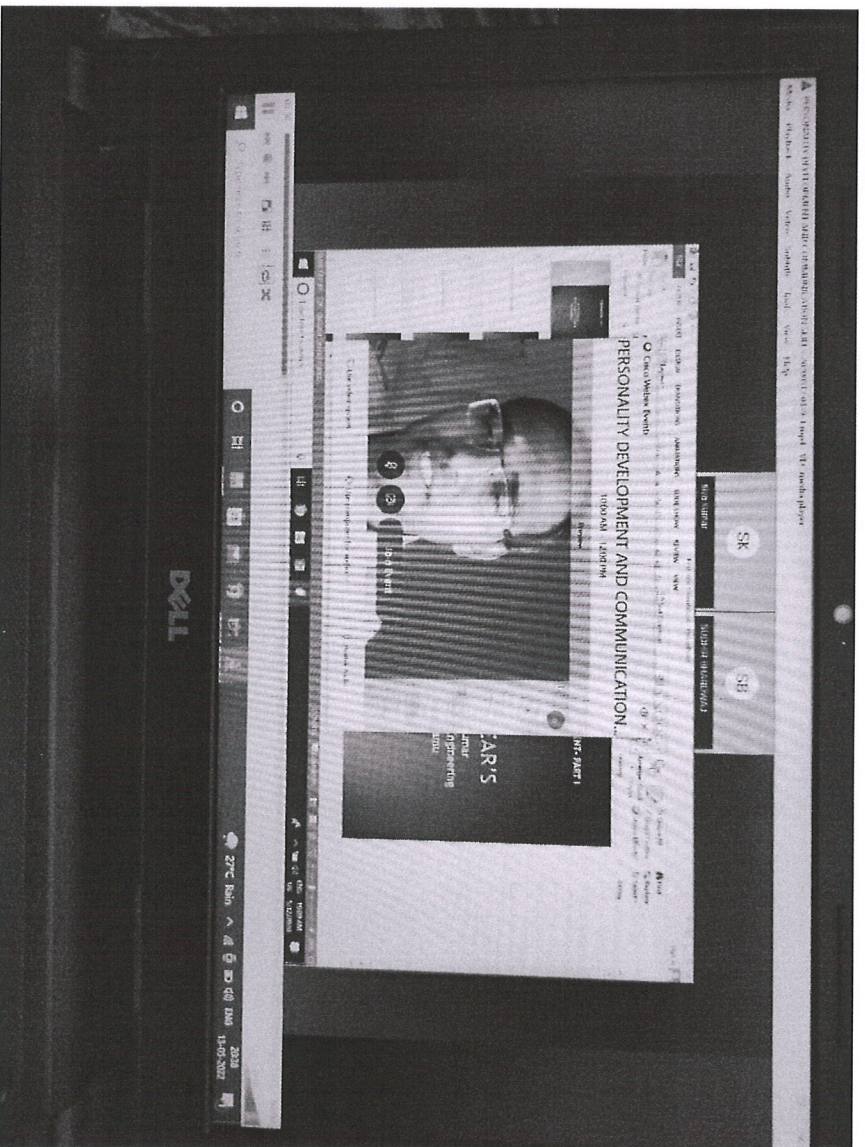




