Event Overview



Esteemed Alumni Speakers

1. Dr. Venkatarami Reddy

Dr.Venkatarami Reddy, a prominent alumnus of JNTU College of Engineering, Anantapur, who served in different administrations in JNTUCEA and JNTUA for a span of 23 years during 1975 to 1998, one of the youngest Vice chancellor during 1998 – 2005, Chairperson of APPSC during 2005 – 2011 and Member of UPSC during 2011 – 2014 has said, that he has reached such eminent positions because of this college education and shown all the gratitude towards the teachers who have imparted great knowledge to them that can compete with any IIT's or NIT's and can prove their skill far better than them. 


2. Dr. Balaveera Reddy

Dr. Balaveera Reddy- A Design Thinker, A Global Education Evangelist, A Strategic Branding & Marketing specialist, Youth Motivator and currently Vice Chancellor at VTU Engineering, was another distinguished alumna who addressed the gathering. He spoke about the importance of entrepreneurships and its necessity in the current situation of the country.Dr. Balaveera Reddy encouraged the students to think beyond the conventional career paths and to embrace innovation and risk-taking. In his words he said "Our country is a developing country and for how many days we will be seeing in the developing mode only. It has to become the developed country and it is in the hands of younger generations." He also mentioned the example of expanding of small enterprise into a huge enterprise by taking an example of *Tarmac busses* started by one person in aerodromes to carry the people from terminal to the jets. His speech was particularly inspiring for young minds aspiring to become entrepreneurs.

They have remembered all the jovial moments they have done in the campus and their interactions with the faculty, and how their teachers dedicatedly imparted the knowledge to the students and made them into the strong personalities in the society. The Alumni were thankful to the college for being such a strong pillar in their life and gave portion of suggestions to the students to work for the enhancement of the country with the knowledge they are gaining from the college.






