- To conduct laboratory examinations from **19.02.2024 to 24.02.2024** and send the award lists in sealed covers to the address mentioned above on or before **29.02.2024 (Thursday)** without fail by registered/speed post. - Complete the first entry of lab externals in EMS by **26.02.2024**.
- You are requested to finalize the attendance particulars of the students for regular examinations and to upload the detained list to the examinations portal 'JNTUA EMS' on or before 05:30 PM of **19.02.2024 (Monday)** without fail.
